Uses evidence-based practices and provides opportunity for further evaluation

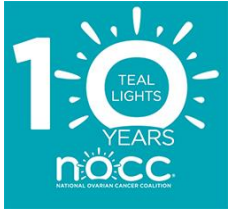

Only 5% of women are diagnosed with ovarian cancer in stage 1, when the 5-year survival rate is 92%, but nearly 80% are diagnosed in the later states when the 5-year survival rate plummets to 29%! Through the **#KNOWOVARIAN** campaign, the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition (NOCC) looks to bring awareness to the importance of ovarian cancer detection, additional funding to help support finding a cure and improving the quality of life for survivors.
