NORTH ENTRY REMODEL: JACKSON BLVD ENTRY CLOSURE REMINDERS

- The North Entry be completed early 2019.
- **DO NOT** cut through Chase Bank and Little Toasted; they are private retail businesses. Through traffic is not allowed and only customers should be accessing their spaces. Normal traffic for building access should utilize the Van Buren or West Plaza entrances only.
- During this project, the West Plaza ADA and revolving doors are accessible after-hours (6:00pm-6:00am Monday-Friday) and on weekends.
- The 24-hour Chase ATMs are available in the Chase Bank vestibule.
- There is **no** smoking/vaping and no bike riding through the restaurant patio area.
 - o There is a designated smoke shelter on the Southwest corner of the West Plaza.
 - o Bikes should always be walked through the restaurant patio when accessing the plaza.
